

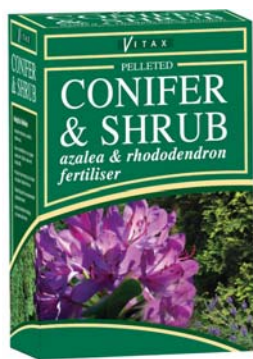

How To Find Us

Gordale is very easy to find on the Chester High Road, midway between Chester and Heswall, around 7 miles from each, and around 10 miles from Birkenhead. Just look out for the brown tourist signs.

From Hoylake and Heswall, follow the A540 towards Chester. Gordale is located on the right hand side of the road, approximately 7 miles from the Heswall Glegg Arms Roundabout. Turn right into Gordale at our new traffic lights.

From the M53, leave at Junction 5 and follow the A550 towards Queensferry. Turn right on the A540 at Two Mills and follow the road. Gordale is just past WaterWorld on the left hand side.

From the M56, follow the motorway to the end at junction 16. Turn left on to the A5117, then right after a short distance, on to the A540. Gordale is just past WaterWorld on the left hand side.

Conifers - the perfect all year round tree

Why Choose a Conifer

Conifers are a wonderful way to add interest to any garden design with an array of different shapes, sizes and colours. Conifers are predominantly evergreen meaning they retain their foliage all year round and so provide colour and form throughout the year.

Conifers are a low maintenance plant requiring little or no pruning, are generally disease resistant and with dwarf varieties available there is a conifer for every situation.

Shape and Form

Being evergreen and often having bold strong shapes, conifers are perfect for bringing form to your garden.

Some examples of where conifers can be used:

- A backdrop to perennials, bulbs, annuals and heathers.
- A lone specimen feature.
- To give height to your borders.
- They also form fascinating shapes when covered with frost or snow in the winter garden.

Tubs and Troughs

Dwarf conifers are quite happy along side other plants in a container or as a specimen on their own.

They look good with winter and early spring flowers, which can as the season progresses be swapped for summer annuals. It is well worth experimenting

with colours and shapes. A pyramid shape in the centre of a planter can produce a very different effect to a prostrate or column like conifer.

Interesting Colour

There is a whole palette of colour shades from blues, greys, golds, greens and bronzes. With some varieties changing colour with the seasons.

Water and Rockery Features

Conifers will enhance any water feature, their strong shapes make excellent reflections and being evergreen you don't have a problem with falling leaves in the autumn.

Prostrate varieties can be used to hide pool linings around the edge with more upright varieties providing a backdrop.

Conifers are also becoming more and more popular in rockeries, with such a wide selection of dwarf and prostrate plants now available.

Screening and Hedges

Any ugly feature such as an oil tank or a garage can be screened by conifers and because their evergreen qualities it will last all year round. They also make good hedges and some varieties can be clipped into topiary designs in time.
